

# 1.19 Release notes

The focus of this release is to provide a log of SMS details, and to allow the school administrators to identify where the SMS credits are being used. There are also other various improvements and issue resolutions.

## Parents

### Improvements

- [CR-780] - Kiosk Usability - The pages within the Kiosk application have been updated for consistency and usability improvements.
- [CR-974] - The Remember Me functionality has been removed from the uEducateUs application. Having the option to allow users to access the system without having to enter their login credentials, was a breach of security and was not in line with the Australian Government security requirements.

- [CR-482] - Semester Reports - Attendance comments can now be edited on a per student basis.
- [CR-562] - Student report scores from Cases21 can now be imported into the uEducateUs system using the XML file format (previously, only CSV format was supported).
- [CR-774] - Teachers and Administrators can now view the latest student curriculum report scores for entire cohorts. This feature is available to view by student, class or year level under their respective Overview sections (e.g. To view a single student's latest curriculum scores, go to Student Overview).
