

1.21 Release notes

Welcome to the uEducateUs 1.21 release.

The release notes have been set up to allow the different user types to easily find the issues that are relevant to them. *For example, if you are a parent, you only need to look in the **Parents** category to find all issues that affect you.*

The focus of this release was providing the ability for School Administrators to bulk upload student photographs, giving School Administrators greater flexibility in controlling Conversations between parents and teachers, plus other various improvements and issue resolutions.

We encourage your feedback, as this feedback continues to help drive the direction and content of our release cycles.

Issues

- [CR-1115] - Parent/Teacher Interviews: Resolved an issue that was causing certain interview timeslots to show as available even though the parent could not make any bookings.
- [CR-1085] - Resolved an issue that was causing the error: ***The URI you submitted has disallowed characters*** to be displayed when accessing the uEducateUs system via an iPad or Mobile Phone.

Teachers

Improvements

- [CR-1129] - Well-being > Behaviour: It is now possible for Admins and Teachers to edit and delete the Behaviour Descriptors. **Note:** *any edits made will be retrospective, so in certain cases it will be better to create a new descriptor rather than editing the current one.*
- [CR-1145] - Teachers can no longer communicate with parents and students outside of their own class assignments. An option has been added to allow Administrators to allow teachers to communicate to a wider audience, if the school requires/allows it.

New Features

- [CR-1002] - Allow school administrators to upload the student's profile photos in bulk.
- [CR-1125] – An **Inactive Families** report has been added to the Data Lists module. This report will make it easier for school Admins to identify the parents that are not using the uEducateUs system.

Improvements

- [CR-1129] - Well-being > Behaviour: It is now possible for Admins and Teachers to edit and delete the Behaviour Descriptors. **Note:** *any edits made will be retrospective, so in certain cases it will be better to create a new descriptor rather than editing the current one.*
- [CR-1145] - Teachers can no longer communicate with parents and students outside of their own class assignments. An option has been added to allow Administrators to allow teachers to communicate to a wider audience, if the school requires/allows it.
- [CR-852] - **Victorian Private schools** can now generate the **Student Residential Address Report** in .CSV format to be forwarded to the Victorian Dept. of Education.
